NEW RECYCLING GUIDELINES

If you use St Timothy's kitchen, please dispose of your rubbish and recycling in line with the new guidelines put out by Christchurch City Council. These are displayed on the kitchen wall. Most food and flowers can still go into the white waste bucket, except tea bags. Tea leaves are fine, but the bags have a small amount of plastic in them, hence must go into the rubbish bin.

My thanks to everyone who does take care when disposing of rubbish. I am still taking soft plastic to the Warehouse drop-off point each week. That, and your other recycling efforts, do make a difference to the amount that we would normally send to the landfill.

In the foyer of both churches are some guidelines of alternative places to take your unwanted goods that are not able to go in the yellow city council bins. Please help yourself to a copy.
