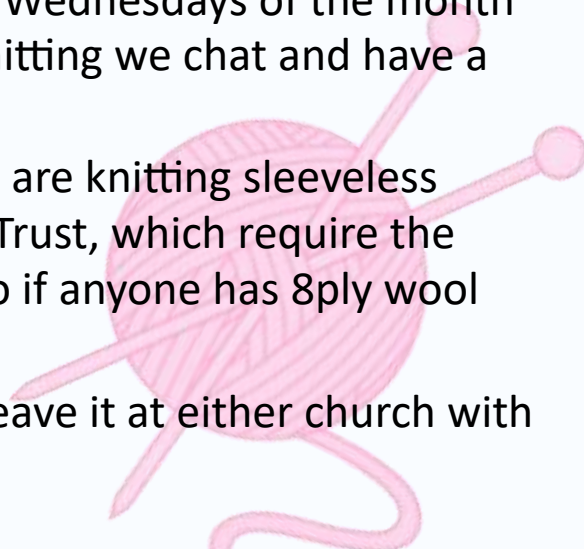

### MISSION PARTNERS UPDATES

#### ***Howard and Gladys Karaka - Maori Evangelists NZ***

When I read prayer points from Howard and Gladys I am always struck by how humble, evangelistic and outward looking they both are, as they seek to share the gospel through the Marae ministry in Port Waikato. Pray for God to strengthen them and give them wisdom as they respond to requests to services by local Iwi. They plan to re-open St John's Tamatera Maori Anglican Church which has been closed for 6 years.

#### ***Liz***

Praise God for the construction work which has started on the new hostel buildings for 100 Boys and also for the Girls Hostel which reopened in March. The hostel students are sitting their university entrance exams in mid-April, so please pray for them as they sit these exams.

Pray for Liz also, that she would discern God's direction as new opportunities arise, that she would become aware of how and where her skills and gifting can be best used.

#### ***Nick and Tessa – Uganda***

OneDay Health which Nick co-founded has made great progress in providing local people in rural Uganda with access to healthcare. There are currently 41 health centres up and running with expansion into Eastern and Western Uganda. They are now looking at opportunities to establish OneDay Health centres in Malawi.

OneDay Health has recently been accepted into the London School of Economics accelerator programme, which has opened up connections and a large financial grant which they are very thankful for.

There is a poster on the Missions Board, in the foyer at St Tim's, giving a summary of the milestones reached by OneDay Health in 2023. Please have a read of this when you have the opportunity.

Tessa is involved in social justice, particularly in land disputes between local tribes which have been violent lately.

Please pray for strength and wisdom for Tessa, Nick and the team at OneDay Health.

## NEXUS

I don't want to finish Mission Matters without mentioning Nexus, which is the ministry to our local multi-ethnic community. We have the privilege in the Burnside-Harewood area of living and working alongside so many people of different ethnicities and I am thankful to have many members of our parish who originate from countries other than New Zealand. We learn so much from each other as we worship together and I'm very grateful to God for our diverse community. Let's continue to pray for Shawn and Christine as they head up Nexus, that God would give them wisdom, strength and discernment and build up the team around them.
