There has been another thing I have been counting. It started when I was feeling a bit down about the things that had either been postponed or cancelled. One major event was the Abbey in Wellington. I was set to head off with a small team from our church as well as numerous other Anglican youth pastors and leaders. I had just spent a large section of Tuesday double checking my schedule and had spent extra time at the office confirming. I began making the trip home when a notification popped up that we were going to go into lockdown. My first reaction was "Goodbye 'The Abbey' and good times" :(However, I came across a post with the following:

Prayer request

As you may know, I lived on the Thai-Myanmar (Burmese) border several years ago. I worked with children and youth who were refugees. Many had fled to the border to escape violence within their own country. I received this message this morning from a friend I taught alongside with:

Tue 24/08/2021 06:38

Please pray for H in Burma an ex-student from the ministry on the border, his town is overtaken by the army and he thinks he could be forced to be a Porter (being used by the army, especially in landmine areas). The children's home there is also surrounded. Please pray for the minority groups especially Karen and Kachin as the situation is intensifying in those areas. There is fighting and people have been taken, tortured, shot at and not seen again.

While the world is focused on Covid, Myanmar has increased the intensity of its attacks on many minority ethnic groups. Please pray that God would be there with people who are suffering at the hands of the Myanmar army. Pray that he would change the hearts of the leaders and that they would come to know Christ. Ultimately this is the only way we will see lasting peace in Myanmar.
