2023 LENTEN APPEAL - MUD BRICK PROJECT

The Mud Brick project, I mentioned in the March Mission Matters, came about as a direct result of the Golden Oldies many short-term mission trips to Fiji, that an ex-parishioner, Graeme Mitchell, led. These groups of older people had a desire to build an ongoing relationship with the villagers they visited and to help lift them out of poverty. Wisely, those they were working alongside, were asked to provide practical, doable input, too.

The need for cyclone – resistant housing is high in Fiji and using a readily available resource is a practical solution. It takes approximately 8000 bricks to build one house, and it costs about \$2NZD for one brick. Every \$2 you give will literally build foundations for climate resilient communities.

Currently, the site conditions are restricting production because the bricks and machinery are exposed to the elements. Your donation will go towards vital infrastructure to make the production process more effective; secured and weatherproof site offices, maintenance for brick pressing machines, tools, equipment, and training. Additionally, your support will enable the team to scale up with flow on benefits.
