MISSION MATTERS

Greetings Parishioners, continued from last week's Mission Matters, here are updates I listened to from:

Rev. Michael Hartfield, the National Director of Anglican Missions.

The AM arm of Anglican Missions covers the first two Marks of Mission (Tell, Teach) and the other arm, Anglican World Aid Aotearoa – AWA the other three (tend, transform, treasure). It is this latter arm that qualifies for Government top ups and donation tax rebates.

Additionally, AM has joined a group of like-minded agencies called the Emergency Alliance that stream-lines responses to disasters.

As needs assessments are completed, the funds raised by AM to help those affected by Cyclone Gabrielle have started to be distributed. The focus will be on those projects/people that may miss out on Government support. Helping with the restoration of Māori graveyards and storm- damaged churches is now progressing. The restoration of the churches is a priority as they are used as gathering points when disaster strikes.

Rev. Rosie Fyfe, National Director of NZ Church Missionary Society

Rosie gave updates about some of the MP's – she had been to Uganda to visit Nick and Tessa and commented on the way they were living in a thatched house amongst the people they serve. No gated communities for them, although Nick does take a towel when he visits friends, who live with more facilities than he and Tessa do. The towel is for a welcome shower!!

Rosie also spoke about the partnership NZCMS have formed with the Northern Māori Diocese to help fund and strengthen the Evangelist initiative.

She also outlined the partnership they have formed with AsiaCMS. Essentially this is to help fund the work of Asia CMS Mission Partners. In many ways this makes sense - Asian serving Asian.

I came away from both meetings feeling reassured that our two primary Mission Agencies are in good hands. AM, in particular, have modern systems in place to comply with legalities and best practice. Neither have lost sight of the Great Commission.
