What is Discipleship?

The reality is that we're constantly being formed by the world around us. What we give attention to will shape our perceptions of the world and what we value. The apostle Paul taught that the good news of Jesus changes the way we live and how we are formed. In Romans 12 he urged his fellow Christians "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."



Discipleship is the process by which we are being formed into the likeness of Jesus Christ which requires our minds to be renewed so that what we perceive and value lines up with the ways of his kingdom. 'Disciple' means follower, so for us to be disciples of Jesus then we're seeking to follow Jesus and to live the way he lived. Does this mean we should give up our smartphones and cars and walk around in sandals and robes? Well you can if that's what you feel called to! But what we're seeking to do as disciples is to examine how Jesus lived his life and apply those principles to our own lives. What we see in Jesus's life is that he lived a three-dimensional life. This is clearly demonstrated in Luke 6:12-19.

Firstly, he sought his Father's will by spending time in prayer.

Secondly, he gathered a community of disciples that he did life with and mentored.

Thirdly, he reached out with compassion to those in need.

For us then, as his disciples today, we want to grow in our relationship with God by spending time in prayer, reading the scriptures and listening to what God has to say to us personally. We also want to grow in our relationships with the other believers that we are in community with by gathering together regularly, encouraging others in their journey of faith and receiving encouragement ourselves. Then we want to grow in our compassion for those who don't yet know Jesus and find opportunities to share his love for them.

This process of becoming like Jesus is a lifelong investment from each of us as we commit every area of our lives to Jesus and ask him to make us more like him. We're choosing not to be formed by the world around us but for Jesus to make us into the people we were always meant to be.
