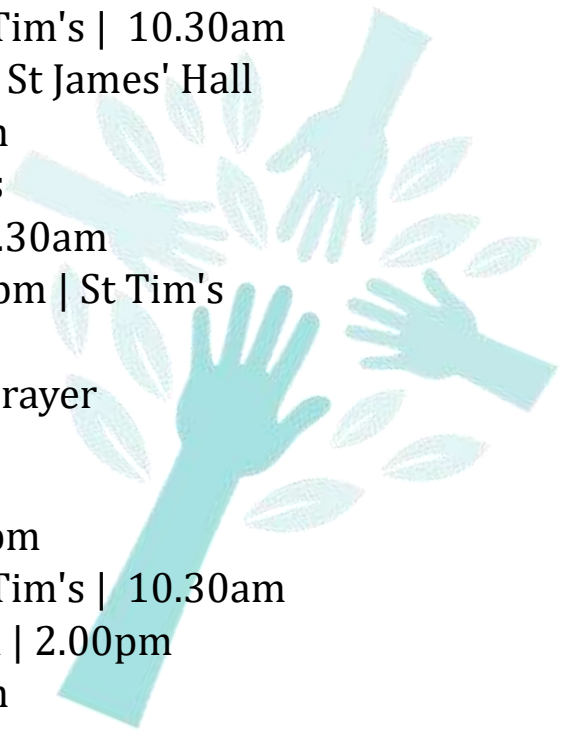

A big THANK YOU to Maurice for his dedication and hard work in keeping St James' so presentable. His efforts will be sorely missed!



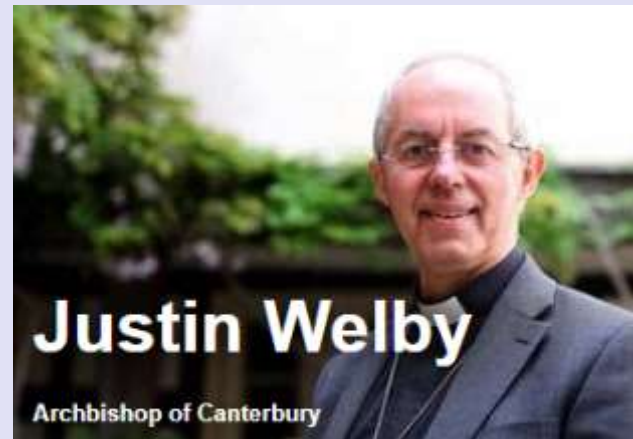

THE FIRST MARK OF MISSION - TELL

This Sunday our focus is on the First Mark of Mission - to proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom - which is the unconditional love and forgiveness of God through Jesus. The Kingdom describes what the World would be like if we lived according to God's standards and displayed the love and grace of our Lord. This First Mark is foundational to the other four, each of which points us to a lifestyle that reflects those kingdom values.

Unfortunately, the way we "tell", often puts people off Christianity for a variety of reasons. I particularly like the suggestions, the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, gave in a lecture arranged by the Deo Gloria Trust in England.

In brief they were:

- Practise the Golden Rule – faith conversation should ideally be conducted with mutual respect and understanding . Don't ridicule another's faith.
- Truly listen to the other. Try not to bring your own biases to the conversation. Every person is valued by God.
- Be prepared to learn, as most faiths have droplets of light.
- Be conscious of our history – in this county, for instance, Christianity and colonisation are sadly viewed as intertwined.
- Build relationship, so the other knows we care for them, even if they reject the message we have to share

Essentially, I think, ++ Justin is encouraging us to undergird our telling with love and respect.'
