THE FIFTH MARK OF MISSION - TREASURE

This Sunday our focus is on the Fifth Mark of Mission - To strive to safeguard the integrity of creation and sustain and renew the life of the earth.

This was added in 1990, by the Anglican Consultative Council (ACC – 8). In adopting this Fifth Mark of Mission, ACC-8 stated: “We now feel that our understanding of the ecological crisis, and indeed of the threats to the unity of all creation, mean that we have to add a fifth affirmation.” Underpinning this Mark is the biblical theology of creation, which essentially says that God has committed Himself to the total redemption and restoration of the whole of creation.

Sometimes though, I do wonder what God feels when he takes an over-arching view of how we humans treat one another, other creatures and the Earth we have been blessed with to sustain us. Despite everything we have done, and continue to do, He has committed Himself to saving and restoring both us and creation. As Christians it is our privilege to join in with God’s restorative work.

Creation care is complex and involves sound science and a balance of compassion and justice. Any stance taken on environmental issues need to be carefully considered to ensure ‘solutions’ do not create

unintended problems for other creatures and the vulnerable.

As a Parish we have already tinkered with changes in an ad hoc manner - recycling, community garden, composting. Maybe it is time to draw up an environmental policy, that ensures all aspects of Parish life are carried out in an environmentally friendly way. For instance, when I'm buying cleaning products

for the church, while I would prefer to buy environmentally friendly products, currently I am reluctant to buy them if they are the most expensive brand.

This policy issue was raised earlier this year at a Mission Team Meeting. However, it was not taken any further as there seemed to be too much going on in the Parish. Please think about this topic and give feedback to those on the Mission Team or Vestry Members.

As your Mission Motivator I do hope you have gained an appreciation of the width of Mission and, more importantly, want to join in with God's Mission, whether it be next door, locally or overseas. The first step is the hardest, but the peace one obtains when you find your niche is worth it.
