MISSION MATTERS - NOVEMBER

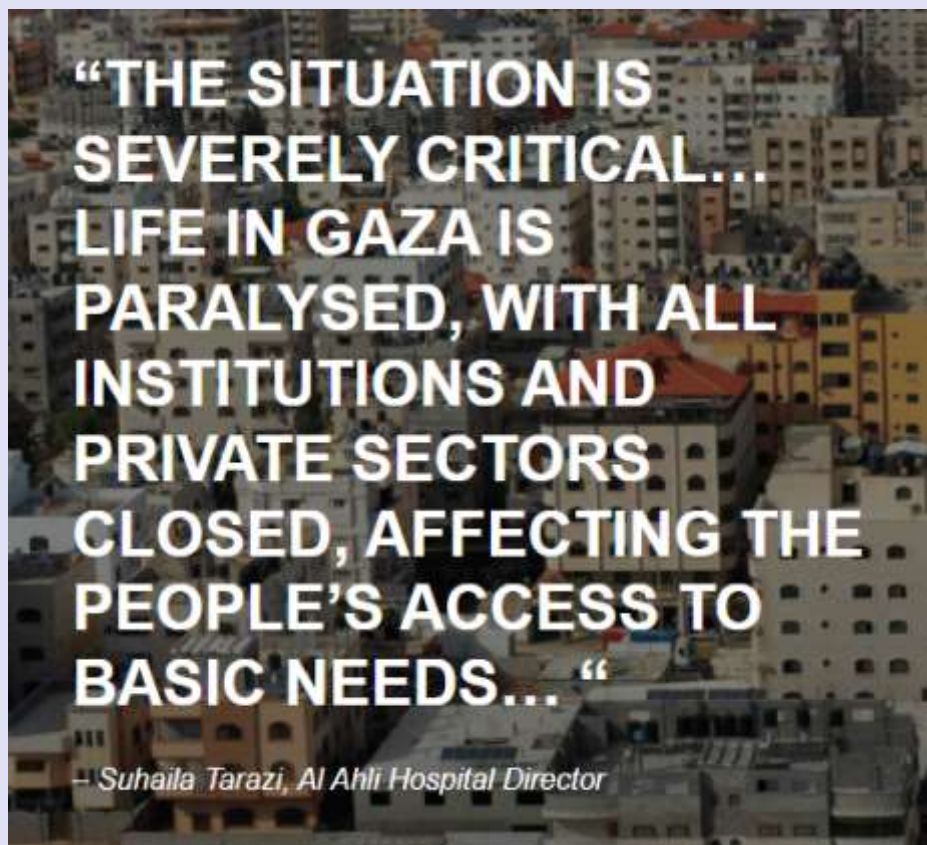
Every night I watch a report from Gaza and every night my heart sinks as I view the suffering, death, and destruction. While it is the men who are normally featured, recently I caught a glimpse of a young woman sobbing in the background; for me, she epitomised the collective grief and suffering of the Gazans.

If you long to offer practical help, please consider donating to the appeal that Anglican Missions is promoting for funds for Al Ahli Arab Anglican Hospital that is based in Gaza. In peaceful times, this hospital treats over 45,000 patients a year providing out-patient and in-patient care, including emergency and ambulance services. Its doors are open to everyone in need. It is one

of very few Christian witnesses in the city and is often described as a “beacon of hope”. This, like other hospitals in Gaza, has been extensively damaged and is barely functioning due to lack of resources and power. This Appeal is a world-wide Anglican Communion Appeal, that AM is promoting in Aotearoa. Let’s help ensure the hospital can pay its staff and has the financial resources to source the things they desperately need once Israel lets humanitarian aid into Gaza. You can donate via:

For decades CWS has worked with local partners to tackle hunger. Although they believe there is enough food to feed the world, the difficulty, as always, is access. CWS is not discounting the size of this problem in Aotearoa, but they are suggesting the size and complexity of the problem around the world is greater and ask that you consider giving if you are able to. Each Sunday, during Advent, you will find an aspect of the help CWS provides around access to food highlighted in the newsheet.

Meanwhile, if you are a person who likes to give gifts that are thoughtful, a little different and environmentally friendly, you will find brochures in both churches with a raft of options.

With Joy leaving, and Anneke unwell, there are only two of us remaining. Please approach me if you would like to join us. We meet every two months, and those meetings are relatively informal.
