WHAT HAPPENS NEXT – A FURTHER UPDATE.

As we approach a time of transition it is important to update on a number of matters:

- Firstly, we want to focus on giving Chris and Joy a wonderful farewell in their final days of being with us. We are just so grateful for the ministry of Chris and Joy over the last four and half years.
- On Sunday 28th January we will have a pot luck lunch together for all parishioners followed by a time to honour Chris and Joy and say our farewells. The lunch will commence at 12 noon at St Timothy's.
- Chris will be preaching at our services for the final time on Sunday 4th February. Within the services we will also be praying for Chris and Joy.
- On **Saturday 10th February, all parishioners are invited** to participate in a Future Ministry Consultation at St Tim's (9am – 12.30pm). This is your opportunity to tell us what you want a prospective vicar to know about our parish, and to describe the attributes that you think are important when selecting a new vicar. This process, facilitated by the diocese is such an important moment. Please do make every effort to participate in this consultation as everybody's views are so needed and valuable.
- A profile of the parish will then be compiled. It will inform prospective applicants about our community as well as our parish and church life. It will also describe our buildings and our finances.
- The Bishop will then advertise for people to apply to be the vicar. The advertisement goes to people throughout NZ, and some from overseas. Once applications have closed, a Board of Nomination will have the task of selecting our next vicar. That board is comprised of the Bishop, four nominators from the parish, namely Fiona Johns, Rob Orange, Christine Ng, and Bruce Chapman, and four diocesan nominators.

- Once the Bishop has confirmed an appointment it will be announced by the wardens at our Sunday services. There can be a 3 month gap after this announcement, before the new vicar can actually take up the position.
- Conversations with the Bishop continue regarding the interim ministry after Chris finishes. We will certainly be quick to update everyone on developments. Arrangements are already in place for February.
- To further support the parish through this time of transition, Adrian Brunt will step down as Vicar's Warden from 4th February, although remain on Vestry, and Alison Jephson becomes our Bishop's Warden. We are so thankful to Alison for offering to take up this position as she brings a huge knowledge/relationship with the wider diocese that is so helpful to have at this time. These changes have already been agreed with Bishop Peter.

Please pray and support the process as outlined and for those helping lead our parish during the period after Chris leaves. Please pray for the wardens and nominators, and especially for the person whom the Lord is calling to be our next vicar.

Let us all really support and encourage one another as we go through this period of transition.
