2024 LENTEN APPEAL

As I mentioned last week, over 10% of babies born in the Rwenzori region in Uganda suffer from cleft lip and palate. Cleft is widely perceived as a family curse or punishment from God. Further distress is caused because the baby will have difficulty feeding, fail to thrive, and become malnourished. Cleft lip and palate are linked to a lack of folic acid (vitamin B) and iron in the diet of mothers during pregnancy. For a variety of reasons, in that area, many pregnant mothers don't have access to sufficient nutritional food nor supplements.

While caring for the children now, it is vital to tackle the underlying cause: inadequate maternal nutrition. RSNF's Nutrition and Feeding Programme addresses this issue in multiple ways:

- Education on healthy eating and breastfeeding
- Training families on sustainable agriculture and kitchen gardening practices
- Providing farm tools and nutritional seeds
- Supplying food relief to the most vulnerable

We can help lay a stronger foundation for children and their families by donating to the Lenten Appeal. Your donation will be directed to RSNF's Nutrition and Feeding Programme.
