2024 LENTEN APPEAL

Rwenzori Special Needs Foundation

Since 2010, RSNF have supported hundreds of children with physical and/or mental disabilities, providing surgeries, post-surgery care, vocational and education packages, and home-based support. This happened because, on a visit to Uganda in 2010, Dot Muir from Invercargill saw a need, started small, and over the years other people came on board and the work the foundation does was able to expand.

In January this year, Dot was spring cleaning her phone and found a message from me she hadn't answered. She told me she and a group of helpers are raising \$1,500 every two months, by selling cheese rolls to help support the Foundation. That to me is commitment.

While there are lots of good news stories I could tell you, I suggest you check out the Foundation's Facebook page and browse the photos they have on it. When you do, you will notice some of the programmes have been funded by Accomplish Children's Trust, while others by Anglican Missions. Although AM seems to focus on programmes to do with food and cleft palate, the programmes intersect. A hungry or malnourished disabled child will struggle to learn if not adequately nourished. As with all the work AM funds, it's not only about providing short term relief, but also helping people make changes (knowledge, start-up help – seeds, animals etc) so they can become self-sufficient.

Let's all give, if we can, to help others thrive.

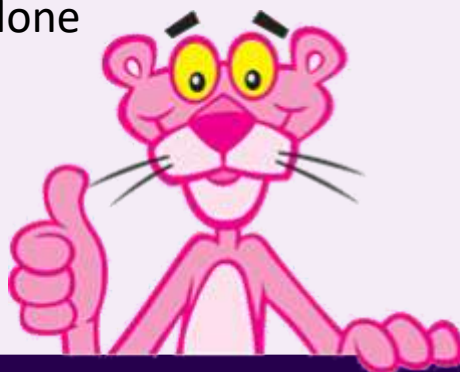
