This fortnight our focus is on baked beans and spaghetti or anything canned that takes your fancy.

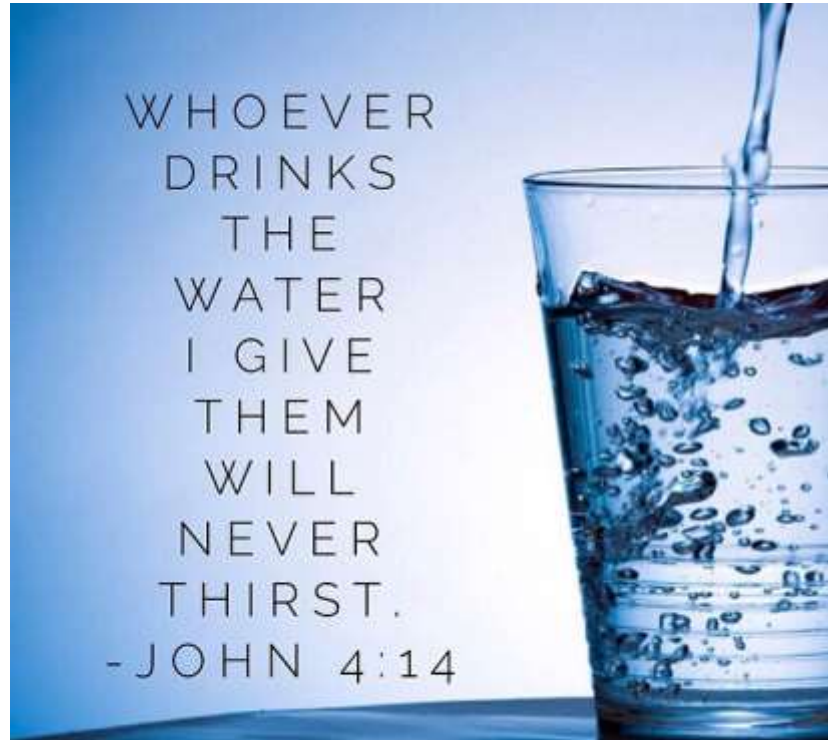

VICAR'S LETTER

Dear Everyone

The Lord is taking us on a journey.

On Pentecost Sunday the Lord filled or refilled many of us with His Holy Spirit. Praise Him! The Lord gives the Holy Spirit to empower and strengthen us to do the work of proclaiming His kingdom.

“For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He has planned for us long ago.” (Ephesians 2:10 NLT)

The Holy Spirit brings with Him gifts of spiritual power. We see these gifts at work in the life and ministry of Jesus. Over the next three Sundays we will explore how these gifts work and how we can use them.

2nd June: The Gifts of Revelation, Knowledge, Wisdom, and Spiritual Discernment.

9th June: The Gifts of Power, Faith, Healing, Miracles.

16th June: The Gifts of Utterance, Prophecy, Tongues and Interpretation.



God intended these gifts to be used both with the church fellowship to build and strengthen believers and to be used in our work or wherever we happen to be. “Doing good things” or good works with and through the Holy Spirit is not restricted to Sundays or home groups.

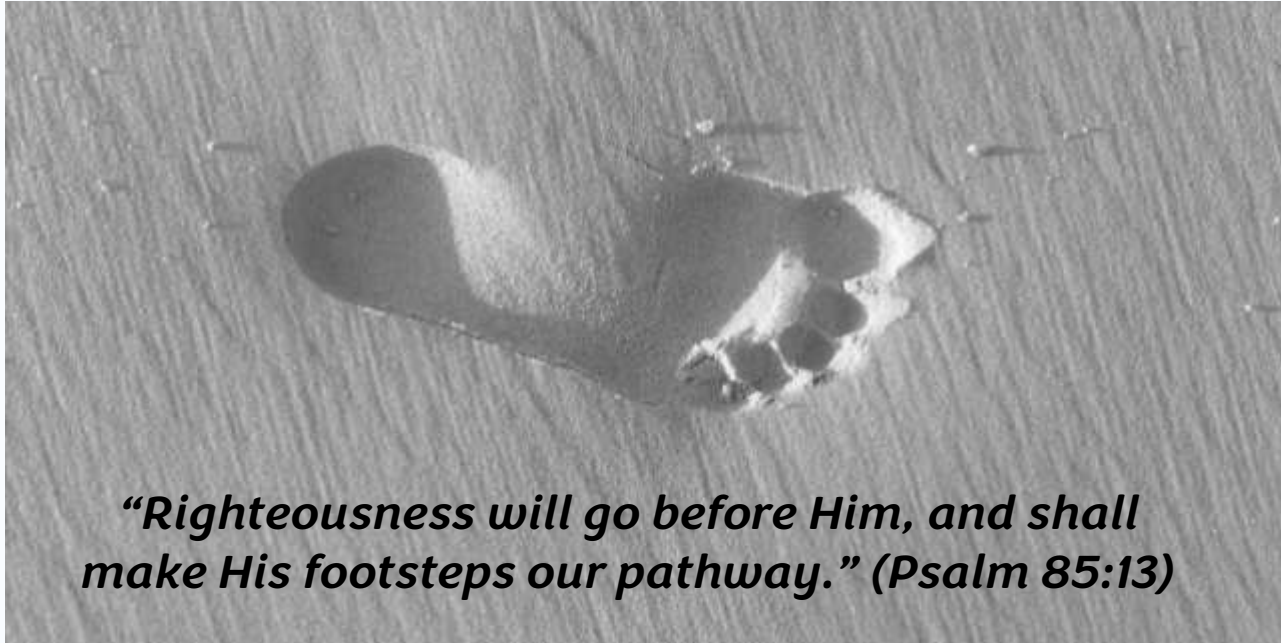
Then from 23rd June through to August we will be doing an eight part series on Prayer. Our relationship with God depends absolutely on prayer. Without prayer the gifts of the Holy Spirit will cease. Without prayer and the relationship with the Lord that it creates, we can only serve in our own strength and self-will. Jesus said of His ministry, “By Myself I can do nothing.” (John 5:30) Since this was true for Jesus the Son of God, it is even more true for us.

Homegroups may like to do a complementary focus on prayer during the

winter term. The Prayer Course produced by Pete Greig, the founder of the 24/7 prayer movement, is a basic 8 week on-line video course which is totally free. Everything you need to run the course is available from the website <https://prayercourse.org/sessions/>
