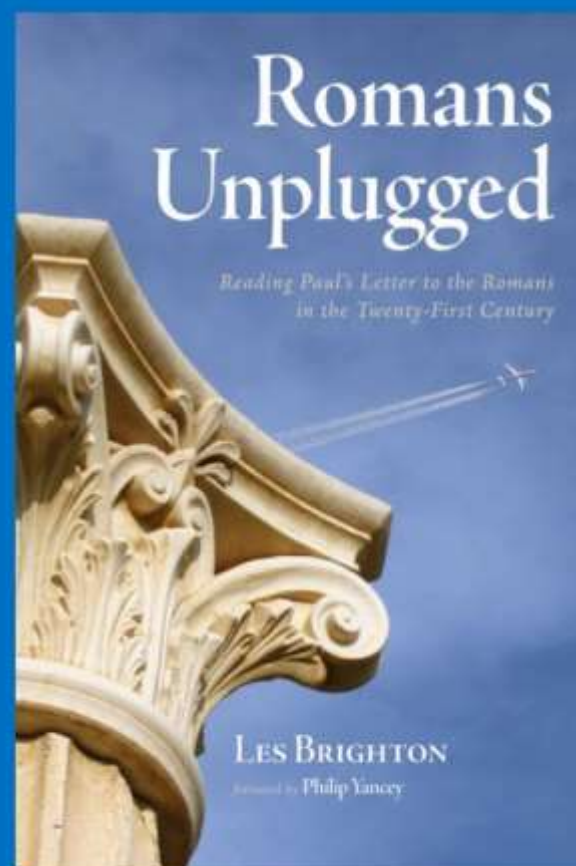
Roman's Unplugged
