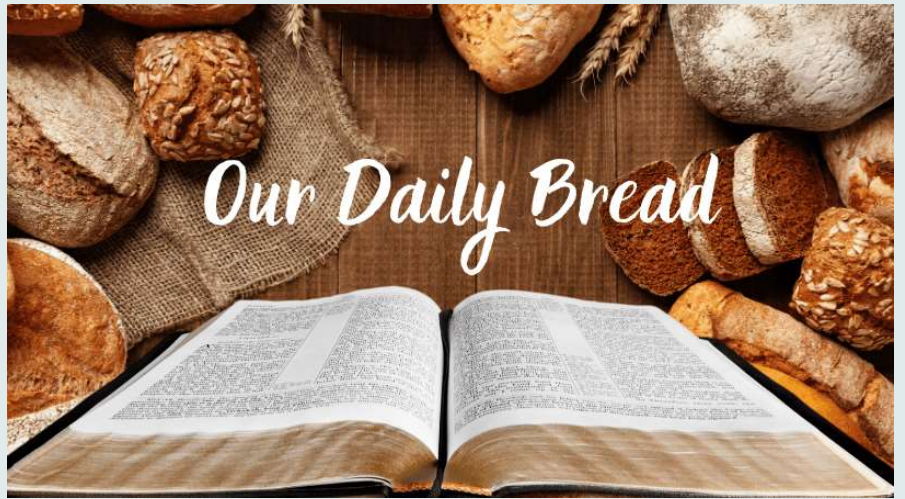

Do you expect to meet friends and enjoy the company of fellow believers?

A service of worship in your local church is a unique experience. There is nothing else like in our society.

Do you come to receive or to give at a service of worship?

The many people who prepare for the service, musicians, leaders and readers, preachers and cleaners, all bring their offering to God and to us. Instead it is an interplay between every one present and the Holy Spirit of God. God is glorified and we are empowered and encouraged by Him and each other to be “Jesus” to all who we meet in the new week.
