I attended the Nexus potluck dinner a couple of weeks ago and loved this excellent all-age event. It was a great evening, with church members and guests enjoying a meal, games and an interactive guest speaker.

MISSION PARTNERS

Howard and Gladys Karaka – Maori Evangelists, NZ

Howard and Gladys are 2 of the 4 NZ Maori Evangelists working with NZCMS. They are based in the Port Waikato area. Please continue to uphold them in prayer. Pray for their protection against spiritual opposition. Pray also that the hearts of those they are reaching out to would be open to receive the Word, that past hurts would be healed and that the Holy Spirit would reveal Christ's love for them.

Liz

Liz is co-facilitating a leadership workshop at the end of July. Pray that it all goes well and that it is a significant growing time for the participants. The people where Liz serves are suffering under economic pressures with some going hungry as they cannot afford enough food to eat. As we have been learning about recently, please pray for them, that God would literally provide their daily bread.

Nick and Tessa – Uganda

OneDay Health, that Nick is the co-founder of, has benefitted from some significant funding. Pray for wisdom for Nick and his colleagues as they decide how to use this finance for the best long-term impact. Nick has recently travelled to the USA where he was interviewed about OneDay Health. There was a point in time when missions was a calling for certain 'appointed' people to convert people groups living in faraway lands to Christianity. Some may continue to argue that the Great Commission in Matthew 28:16-20 is only for a special group of people known as 'missionaries.' However, we must not regard Jesus's instructions as simply a suggestion for we are all to not just share the Good News to all but also to make disciples so that they make disciples. In addition, with diasporas of people groups moving at unprecedented rates around the world, God may have just brought the nations to our doorstep. NZ Stats ending January 2023 showed a 142% increase in migrants arriving in New Zealand with migrants from India, China, and South Africa, taking the top three figures.

Nexus, in essence, refers to a network. The vision we have is to reach an increasing number of (international and local) migrants in and coming to Christchurch. Help them settle down, integrate into the local community, and help meet their different needs (especially spiritual needs), whilst building that friendship into a trusting relationship and introducing God to them.

Missions in the 21st century must be personal and holistic. The church is called to grow through evangelism and discipleship, in other words, to be in service of the world through compassion and justice. Therefore, Nexus Community is the St Tim's and St James' missional community, and we are looking for like-minded, kingdom-mentality people of God to join our core team and be that missing link God can use to forever change another neighbour's lives.
