# AL AHLI HOSPITAL UPDATE

The Al Ahli Hospital is situated in Gaza City and is one of the few Christian witnesses in the Gaza Strip. Prior to the October 2023 invasion by the Israel Defence Force, it was a peaceful haven, in beautiful grounds, where all people could receive treatment.

It has been massively affected by the ongoing conflict. In October 2023, the cancer centre was damaged and 4 staff hurt and two days later a bomb exploded in the carpark killing hundreds who were sheltering there. The staff quickly had the hospital partially functioning, although medical supplies were in short supply and medical staff stretched.

Soon after that, Israeli tanks surrounded the hospital, and staff and patients told to evacuate. During this time some of the staff travelled to Rafah and set up clinics there, as that city was under attack. In early July staff, those seeking shelter, and patients were again ordered to evacuate. This time around, three major news outlets in Israel ran the story of the Church's distress at the closure and the Anglican Archbishop in Jerusalem's plea for the hospital's reinstatement and protection. Astonishingly, it was allowed to reopen.

Because of the number of casualties, there is a constant need for medical supplies and once again Anglican Missions is seeking funds to help the Jerusalem Diocese equip the medical centres they run in Gaza and the West bank.
