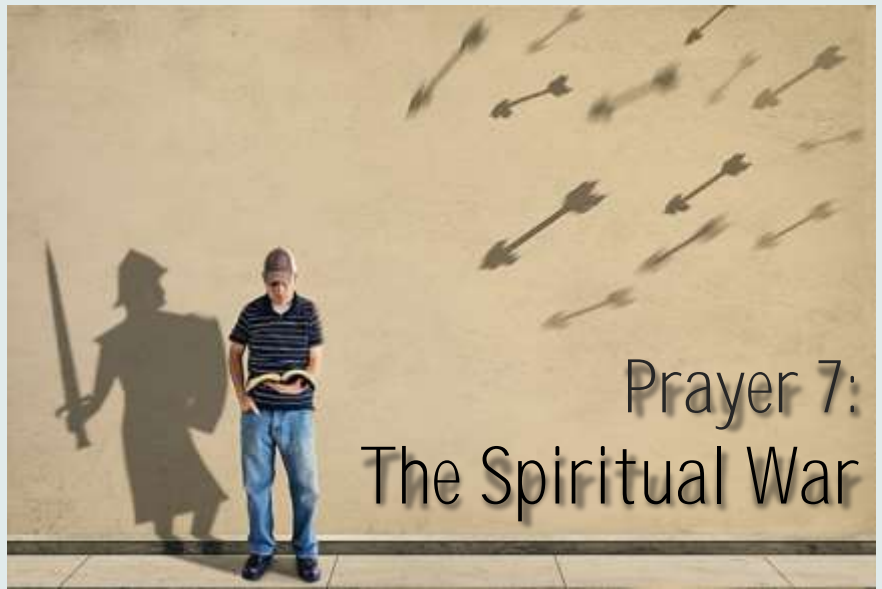

INTERIM VICAR'S MESSAGE

Dear All

During August and September we'll be starting on a journey through the Gospel of Matthew.

Each Gospel presents us with a different picture of Jesus. We need all four to gain a complete picture of Jesus. Mathew's gospel is especially important for Jewish people – the people of the Covenant.

Matthew's gospel more than all the others shows us that Jesus is the long awaited Messiah of Israel who fulfilled the Old Testament prophecies. This is why one of the reoccurring phrases in Matthew is, "that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets."

In modern Israel the Rabbis tell people that the New Testament is a Christian anti-semitic book and no Jew should read it. Jews who dare to open the New Testament start reading Matthew's gospel and are stunned by what they read.

Contrary all that they've been told they discover that Jesus is a Jew, a son of Abraham and descendant of King David. Such revelation is electrifying. Try reading the Gospel of Matthew with new eyes. You may be very familiar with it but it's familiarity can hide all sorts gems of understanding that are just waiting for you to discover. As you read engage your imagination. Try imagining yourself as one of the crowd listening to Jesus and seeing him for the first time.

Join us as we rediscover the Gospels.

ROOF REPLACEMENT AT ST TIM'S

Some weeks ago a leak developed in the roof above the vicar's study and the Parish office. Attempts by parishioners and a commercial firm to fix this leak were unsuccessful and an inspection by FHS Roofing found considerable rust where the two roof sections meet.

The only solution is to replace the lower section of the roof. Vestry has accepted FHS quote of \$10,660. FHS replaced the roof on the main auditorium and proved to be a good contractor.

This is an unforeseen expenditure for the year and the Parish will need to access reserve funds to pay for the project. Any contribution you are able to make will limit the extent to which reserve funds need to be used.

The job has already been scoped out and the contractors expect to start in two weeks weather permitting. In the photo the section of roof above the office windows is what is being replaced. For further information contact Richard Rendle.
